## → **GENERAL INFORMATION**

### Cape Town

Cape Town provides a setting for many scenic wonders, magnificent seascapes and panoramic vistas. This is a city of culture, built on a history that reflects in the architecture, cuisine, music and dance. Together with a warm summer and temperate winter climate and a friendly community, the Western Cape and the Mother City are an ideal holiday destination throughout the year.

### Language

South Africa is a multi-lingual country. Besides the 11 officially recognized languages, scores of others are spoken here, as the country lies at the crossroads of southern Africa. English is generally understood across the country, being the most commonly used language in official and commercial public life.

### Electricity

220/230 volts AC at 50 Hertz. Three pronged plugs are standard and adapters can be bought at most retail stores.

### Currency

One Rand (R) = 100 cents (c). Bank Notes: R200, R100, R50, R20, R10. Coins: R5, R2, R1, 50c 20c, 10c, 5c, 2c, & 1c.

### VAT Refund (Value Added Tax - 14%)

Goods bought in South Africa exceeding R250 allow all tourists to receive a refund of the tax at the airport on their way out. It is advisable to plan an extra hour at the airport for tax refunds, and the best is to have the goods with their receipts ready for the controlling officer.
