→ **NEARBY SIGHTSEEING**

The city has a number of museums that preserve the historical as well as cultural artifacts of the country. The history museums, such as the Apartheid Museum and the Hector Pieterse Museum attract tourist from all parts of the world. The city also has several art museums, like the Johannesburg Art Gallery that features South African and European landscape and figurative paintings, the Museum Africa that covers the history of the city of Johannesburg also prove interesting. Gold Reef City- a large amusement park, The Johannesburg Zoo-one of the largest zoo in South Africa are interesting to visit.

Johannesburg International Airport, the largest and busiest airport in Africa serves the city. The other airports in the city are Rand Airport, Grand Central Airport and Lanseria. Rand Airport It serves as the entry to South Africa from other parts of the world. The Metro railway system in the city connects it with other regions. The Metrobus in Johannesburg operates a bus system that serves as the public transport in the city. Metered taxis and minibus taxis are the two kinds of taxis available in the city. The city has an extensive road network having ring roads, freeways, bypass, highways that ease the traffic congestion in the city.

Language
