#### → LOCATION

Newcastle is situated approximately half way between Durban and Johannesburg off the N3. Newcastle is approximately 338km from Durban and 300km from Johannesburg.

## → **DIRECTIONS TO NEWCASTLE INN**

### From Durban (338km):

Take the N3 national route from Durban. Take the Bergville/Ladysmith off ramp and then turn right towards Ladysmith on the N11. Pass through Ladysmith and continue on the N11 to Newcastle. Turn left into Newcastle and continue on Allen Street through town until you see Newcastle Inn.

### From Johannesburg (300km):

Take the N3 out of Johannesburg toward Durban. Follow this road until you get the the Villiers/Frankfort off ramp (if you reach the WILGE plaza tollgate, you have gone too far!). Continue left until you reach a four way stop, turn right to Warden/Harrismith. Follow this road for 45 minutes until you come to a turnoff on your left, Vrede/Newcastle/Memel. Follow this road for 12km's until you come to a sign post on your right, Memel/Newcastle. Turn right and continue until you get to a T-Junction with traffic lights. Turn left and then left again at the next set of traffic lights, you will see Newcastle Inn.

### **Language**

South Africa is a multi-lingual country. Besides the 11 officially recognized languages, scores of others are spoken here, as the country lies at the crossroads of southern Africa. English is generally understood across the country, being the most commonly used language in official and commercial public life.

### **Electricity**

220/230 volts AC at 50 cycles per second. Three pronged plugs are standard so it is best to take an adapter with you however, adapters can be bought at most retail stores.

### **Currency**

One Rand (R) = 100 cents (c). Bank Notes: R200, R100, R50, R20, R10. Coins: R5, R2, R1, 50c 20c, 10c, 5c, 2c, & 1c.

### VAT Refund (Value Added Tax - 14%)

Goods bought in South Africa exceeding R250 allow all tourists to receive a refund of the tax at the airport on their way out. It is advisable to plan an extra hour at the airport for tax refunds, and the best is to have the goods with their receipts ready for the controlling officer.
